### Graffiti policy

The Parish Council recognises the importance of dealing with graffiti as it arises in order to maintain a pleasant environment and to discourage those who may choose to deface property in this way.

1. All graffiti will be cleaned off or painted over (as appropriate) as soon as is possible after the Parish Council has been informed of the problem
2. The parish clerk will ask the village handyman to deal with the graffiti
3. If the village handyman is not available, the clerk will contact councillors to find one who would be able to do the job
4. The clerk is authorised to deal with this without needing to consult the council
5. If specialised equipment is needed and this needs to be hired, the clerk will consult with the chair of the council
6. The Parish Council will contact the police to report all instances of graffiti.
